College Admission Requirements

1. High School Graduation Requirements

- Subject Requirements:
 - <u>Secondary 4:</u> Mathematics (CST or SN); Science and Technology; History and Citizenship Education; Arts Education
 - Secondary 5: English Language Arts; French Second Language; Ethics and Religious Culture OR Physical Education and Health
- Minimum 54 credits in Secondary 4 and 5
 - 20 of the 54 credits must come from Secondary 5
 - Note: These are the MINIMUM requirements colleges are looking for students who have a competitive academic profile

2. General Admission Requirements

- Competitive overall average
 - This is comprised of all secondary 4 grades in addition to the average of Term 1 and Term 2 grades in Secondary 5
- ➤ High number of credits accumulated across Secondary 4 and 5
- Good marks compared to the class average
 - Courses with more credits attached are worth more
- ➤ Higher quintile rank (Rating is between 1 and 5)
 - 1 = performing in the top 20% of your class
 - 5 = performing in the bottom 20% of your class
- Must be in a graduating position (i.e. passing graduation requirement courses and having earned required amount of credits)

 - Prerequisites courses: Enriched Math, Chemistry, Physics
 - Audition
 - Driver's License
 - Interview
 - Letter of Intent
 - Portfolio
 - Physical Testing
