

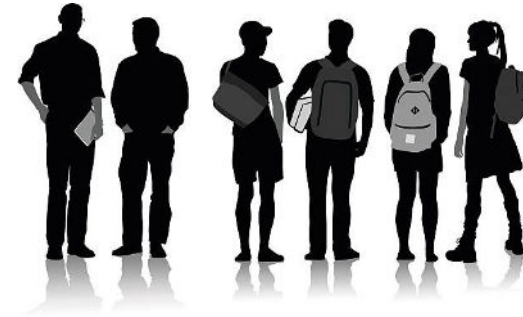
Which documents would I need to register my child?

Once we've established your child may register, we will need:

- Your child's original long-form birth certificate with both parents' full names
- Two Quebec proofs of residency : driver's license, municipal tax bill, cable company bill, Hydro bill, or any other bill from an established company showing the child mother's or father's full name and residential address
- Your child's latest final report card
- Certificate of Eligibility to English Education, if available
- Current Intervention Education Plan (IEP), if applicable
- Any other professional report related to your child's learning or behaviour

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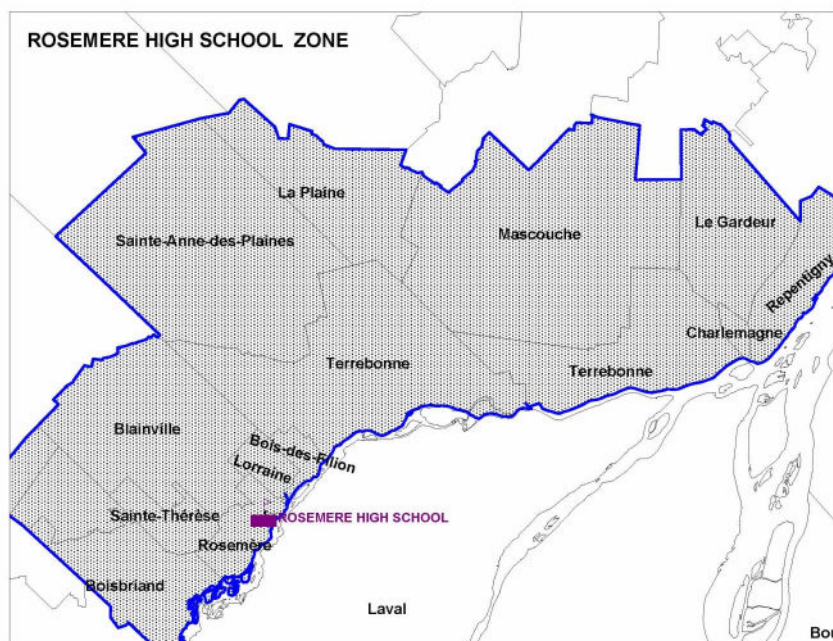
Does my child have eligibility for an English education in Quebec?

A certificate of eligibility is generally issued to children:

- Who have received the major part of their elementary or secondary school instruction in English in Canada;
- Whose brother or sister did the major part of his or her elementary or secondary studies in English in Canada;
- Whose father or mother did the major part of this or her elementary studies in English in Canada;
- Whose father or mother attended school in Quebec after August 26, 1977, and could have been declared eligible for instruction in English at that time.

Do you accept out of zone students?

If your child has eligibility to an English education, there is a possibility for enrollment:

- If you live within the SWLSB territory, you must fill out an **Out-of-Zone Request Form** and send it directly to SWLSB. Applications are taken beginning of February 2024.
- If you live outside the SWLSB territory, you must ask the school board with jurisdiction over your child to complete an **Interboard Agreement** with our board, SWLSB.

Out-of-zone requests will be rendered on or before May 31 of each year. Parents will be advised accordingly. Please note that transportation to and from school will be the parents' responsibility.

What is SWLSB's enrollment priority order for RHS?

- 1 *In-zone student currently attending RHS*
- 2 *In-zone sibling attending SWLSB of student at RHS*
- 3 *In-zone student attending SWLSB school*
- 4 *In-zone sibling (new to SWLSB) of student at RHS*
- 5 *In-zone student new to SWLSB*
- 6 *OOZ student currently attending RHS*
- 7 *OOZ student currently attending SWLSB and in SWLSB territory*
- 8 *OOZ sibling (new to SWLSB) of student currently attending RHS*
- 9 *OOZ new student residing on SWLSB territory*
- 10 *Student attending RHS from outside SWLSB territory*
- 11 *New student from outside SWLSB territory*
- 12 *International students*
