SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

<i>ABSENCES</i>	All students and parents are reminded of the importance of being present for exams whether they are written in class or during the examination period. ANY ABSENCE FROM EXAMS MUST BE 'JUSTIFIED' BY A MEDICAL CERTIFICATE, COURT SUMMONS OR DEATH IN THE FAMILY. As outlined in the Student Agenda, parents are requested not to schedule vacation time during the exam period as these exams cannot be rescheduled.
<i>BATHROOM BREAKS</i>	Students may not leave the exam room for the first hour of the exam, unless it's an emergency, and then only when accompanied by a supervisor.
<i>BUS SCHEDULE DURING EXAMS</i>	During exam time the bus schedule will remain the same as it has all year round. Buses will be available up until and including June 19, as per the regular schedule.
<i>CAFETERIA</i>	The cafeteria will serve lunch up until and including June 9 th .
<i>CODE OF CONDUCT</i>	The regular Code of Conduct applies during the exam period. Secondary 1 and 2 students are NOT permitted to leave school grounds during the exam period. Signing a child out does not override this rule. Parents who sign out their children are expected to pick them up.
<i>ELECTRONICS</i>	All electronics (cell phones, Apple watches, air pods) have to be left in the student's locker. Any student found with these electronic devices in their possession during the exam will have their exam confiscated and given the grade of zero.
<i>EXAMS DURING CLASS TIME</i>	There are many exams held in May and June that occur DURING SCHEDULED CLASS TIME. Teachers will be informing their students of exactly when they will be held. There are also Secondary 5 English and French exams in May and June. These are ministerial exams and are indicated on the Secondary 5 exam schedule (May).
<i>LATE TO AN EXAM</i>	Students who are more than 30 minutes late may not enter the examination room without an administrator's approval. Students arriving after the 30 minutes must sign-in at the General Office and get an admit slip from an administrator. The missed time will not be added to the end time. If the late arrival is later than the halfway mark of the exam, the student will not be permitted to write the exam.
<i>PICK UP AFTER EXAMS</i>	Although buses will run their routes as originally scheduled, parents are strongly encouraged to pick up their children as soon as their exam is over. Students may use their cell phones in the Lower Foyer to notify parents that they are ready for pick-up.
<i>SUPERVISED STUDY SESSIONS</i>	These are sessions offered for students wishing to have a space to study with access to a teacher in that subject for questions. These are "drop-in" tutorials, meaning the students' attendance is voluntary.
